Uljana Semjonova 10th Basketball Cup for Girls

I. General information

1. These regulations determine the procedure for the "Uljana Semjonova 10th Basketball Cup for Girls" (hereafter - the Competition) in 2022.

2. The Competition aims are:

2.1. to provide Riga's young basketball players with an international tournament experience;

2.2. to promote women's basketball in Riga;

2.3. to honor the famous basketball player Uljana Semjonova.

3. The tournament is organized by Sports and Youth Board of Education, Culture and Sports Department of Riga City Council (hereafter - Organizer).

II. Place and time of the competition

4. The tournament takes place from 27th till 30th October 2022.

5. The competition takes place at the sports bases of Children and youth basketball school "Rīga": f sports base "Daugavas sporta nams" (Krišjāņa Barona Street 107) and sports base "Rīdzene" (Krišjāņa Barona Street 97C).

6. Competition regulations and information about the Competition are published on the website www.sports.riga.lv.



III. Competition program and conditions

7. Tournament takes place in two age groups:

7.1. born in 2006 and younger;

7.2. born in 2008 and younger.

8. In the age group “Born in 2006 and younger” there are six teams competing: three invited teams and three teams from Riga.

9. In the age group “Born in 2008 and younger” there are six teams competing: three invited teams and three teams from Riga.

10. Competition is held according to FIBA rules.

11. At the group stage of the Competition each team plays once with every other team.

12. Game time at the group stage is 4 x 8 minutes.

13. Group stage games are held 27th, 28th, 29th October.

14. Finals are held on 30th October.

15. Game time in finals is 4 x 10 minutes.

16. According to the results of the group stage, finals are held as follows:

16.1 for the 5th place – holders of 5th and 6th place in the group;

16.2 for the 3rd place – holders of 3rd and 4th place in the group;

16.3 for the 1st place – holders of 1st and 2nd place in the group.

IV. Scoring

17. For the win each team gets 2 points, for loss – 1 point, for breaking the Competition rules or not attending the game – 0 points.

18. The team that gets more points gains higher place in the group tournament.

19. In case of equal number of points, the following team gains higher place:

19.1. the one that gets more points in mutual games;



19.2. the one that has better difference between scored and missed ball in mutual games;

19.3. the one that has better difference between scored and missed ball in all games.

V. Applications and financial regulations

20. Team application with players names, surnames and date of birth with a doctor's permission to participate in the competition must be submitted until the beginning of the competition.

21. The coach is responsible for the compliance of players' state of health for participation in competitions, as well as compliance with the epidemiological safety measures prescribed in regulatory acts designed to limit the spread of the Covid-19 infection.

22. The Organizer ensures compliance with Personal data processing law.

23. Photographs and/or video images taken during Competition can be published on the organizer's web sites (including stored in the publicly available archives), printed publications, recordings, and live TV.

24. Organizer covers accommodation, meals, and local transport costs for invited teams.

25. The day of arrival of the invited teams is 27th October (from 12.00).

26. The day of departure is 30th October (until 12.00).

VI. Awarding

27. All the competing teams are awarded with the cups from Organizer.

28. 1st to 3rd place of each age group is awarded with medals (15 persons).

29. Best five players of each age group are awarded with prizes.

30. Participants of the tournament are awarded with commemorative prizes.
